Legendary Bentley, 1930 Le Mans

At 4pm on Saturday the 21st June 1930 the greatest automotive duel of the era was about to be played out. The 'Bentley Boys' were taking on the might of the Mercedes Supercharger. After a thrilling race Bentley came through victorious with Kidston crossing the line in first place, sharing the victor's laurels with Barnato. The Mercedes was vanquished! The press headlines of the day read 'Drama of New British Speed Victory', and 'Millionaire wins for England'. The 1930 Le Mans became part of the Bentley legend.
